Maja Petrić unveils Specimens of Time: Mykonos, a mesmerizing continuation of her generative light sculpture series. 





The

photographs of Vivi Chanioti are an internal record of Mykonos, coming from a person who is connected to the island experientially, and not as a visitor, as she lives here all year round. Her sensitive eye seems to flow between shapes and

shades –often between white and black. So when my first question included the expression "another Mykonos", Ms. Chanioti's response was that she did not agree with the term "another Mykonos". "I consider myself lucky and privileged so as to see the island all year round, witnessing the seasons changing before my eyes. People are used to the tourist summer aspect of the island. But Mykonos and its people are here, twelve months a year, with a more relaxed mood in the winter months and a very fast pace in the summer. Photographically I work more as an observer of this cycle." A cycle that, as is evident on her website, is divided among the people, the seascape and the ambassador of Mykonos, the pelican named Petros, who appeared half-dead in the sea in 1958 and was rescued by a captain for him to become one of the most recognisable images. And it is a fact that Petros appears in the photos of Vivi Chanioti with a depth and an emotion dissimilar to anything in which we have seen him before. Apart from Petros, she is photographically moved and surprised by "the way the light 'embraces' the island, especially during the winter months, when the light is more intense. When it comes to a specific spot, I love the church of Paraportiani; there's a wonderful play there with light and shadow," she says. As for the contrast between the landscapes of Vivi Chanioti, with their own

poetic hues, and Mykonos as we know it, she emphasizes: "Most people know Mykonos from the summer photos with the beaches, the sunbeds, the nightlife. I think it's interesting for someone to see the normal rhythms of the island. I prefer to photograph in the non-summer months, I like the light more and because of my job I have more time to devote to it." In the end, what is Mykonos for Vivi Chanioti? "My Mykonos is no different from Mykonos for anyone else. I just listen to the island and try to respect and pay attention to the beauty of the landscape that unravels so generously before us" she replies. She goes on commenting on its future: "I






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like the cosmopolitan side of Mykonos, I've loved the island since I was born. I am not sad about anything, but I am concerned about its future, I think we should respect the island more. It is a destination that for more than seventy years has been a reference point for tourism in Greece. I would like its future to be just as bright, always respecting the place and its inhabitants." So is there a remnant of some authentic Mykonos somewhere that draws its charm from the past? "Although in recent years the tourist development has changed Mykonos a lot, there are still those small precious pieces that are always there to be discovered when one wants to. A walk to Yialos in the morning, a walk to Armenistis to see the sunset, a traditional festival, a walk to the square of Ano Mera" she answers. As for what draws her to photography, Vivi Chanioti refers to the instantaneous that can freeze time: "I think, like most photographers, I'm drawn to capturing the moment that will never come back exactly the same again. It's a unique feeling," she says and lets us wander through the paths of her personal impression of Mykonos.

Vivi Chanioti was born and raised in Athens. She comes from Mykonos, where she has been living for the last few years with her family. She has been involved in photography since she was very young and she is self-taught. Her favourite subjects are landscape photography and recording the daily life of the island's inhabitants. She has had solo photography exhibitions and she has taken part in many group exhibitions. Her photographs are in private collections in Greece and abroad.

AGGELOS BAKOPOULOS

THE TALENTED EXECUTIVE CHEF OF BILL & COO, TALKS ABOUT THE ELEVATED GASTRONOMIC EXPERIENCE OF YEVO, A CULINARY CONCEPT FOCUSING ON LOCALITY AND PERSONALIZATION.

Aggelos

Bakopoulos has had a long-standing career in the culinary world and, since last year, has taken the helm of gastronomy at Bill & Coo. He stands out for his consistency, discipline, and passion in every project he undertakes, resulting in the swift establishment of Bill

& Coo's new gastronomic identity—an evolution that has already earned the hotel a prestigious award at the FnL Awards. This year, he says, the focus at CooZest will be even more centred on seasonality and quality ingredients, while YĒVO will feature three different menus full of surprises and unexpected twists.

After a year at the gastronomic helm of B&C, what have you taken away from the experience?

The first year was full of challenges, growth, and deep satisfaction. It was an opportunity to better understand the hotel's dynamics, the needs of our guests, and to build a solid foundation of creativity and quality. We've gained valuable experience, confidence, and an even greater sense of responsibility towards what the Bill & Coo name represents.

What's new this year in the gastronomic scene at B&C?

This year at CooZest, we're focusing on creating an even more expressive relationship with seasonality and quality ingredients. We're experimenting with new techniques that respect tradition while adding a modern twist. At the same time, we've designed three different menus at YEVO, where we aim to focus on flavour and surprise.

What does the award for Yevo at the FnL Awards mean to you?

It's a great honour and confirmation that the work we do passion, discipline, and faith in our vision can truly be recognised. YĒVO is a heartfelt creation, and the award gives us the motivation to push even further.

How do you think local identity blends with international gastronomic trends?

The combination happens when there is respect. Local tradition is the foundation—it's the "voice" of the place. International trends help us express ourselves more creatively, but they shouldn't distort the essence. When technique serves the authenticity of the raw ingredients, that's when something at the same time truly modern and Greek is born.

What do you particularly appreciate about the island's local products?

The intensity of the flavour. From the capers and sun-dried tomatoes to the cheeses and small aromatic herbs—everything has character. This "roughness" of Mykonos' land gives us ingredients with strength that don't need much to speak for themselves on the plate. In your opinion, what makes Mykonos so unique and resilient? Mykonos has a unique combination: an international vibe, a cosmopolitan pulse, yet a core of authenticity that remains. It

knows how to evolve without losing its identity. And of course, the island's energy, the hospitality of its people, and the light of Mykonos are elements you can't find anywhere else.

What makes a chef go from good to great?

Constant curiosity, humility, and the ability to listen—to the ingredients, to your team, to your guests. Technique is fundamental, but what takes you to the next level is emotional intelligence and the desire to tell a story through your food. When you cook with honesty, you always move forward.

How easy is it to be a couple with mrs Eleftheroglou in both life and work?

It's not always easy, but it's certainly authentic. We know each other extremely well, we trust each other's capabilities, and that creates a very solid foundation. There are tensions, as with any creative collaboration, but our shared goals and our love for what we do bring us together every day.

Local tradition is the foundation – it'the voice of the place. International trends belp us exress ourselves more creatively.

OLGA ELEFTHEROGLOU

THE HEAD CHEF OF COOZEST, LOCATED AT THE COAST BILL & COO, SHARES HER CREATIVE APPROACH TO COOKING AND TALKS TO US ABOUT THIS YEAR'S CONCEPT AT THE RESTAURANT.

Olga

Eleftheroglou leaves her feminine imprint on the culinary world, in a demanding environment full

of ongoing challenges. Partner in life with Angelos Bakopoulos, she is the chef at CooZest, where she unveils a more experiential way of cooking. This year, she promises a more sensory approach to Mediterranean cuisine, as she herself describes it, with a deep sense of hospitality by the sea.

After a year at the gastronomic helm of B&C, what have you taken away from the experience?

It was an intense year, full of learning and reinvention. Through CooZest, I felt I could express a freer, more experiential way of cooking. I gained confidence, but also an awareness of what it truly means to cook in a space with such high expectations—from both the guests and from myself.

What's new this year in the gastronomic scene at B&C?

At CooZest this year, we're taking a more sensory approach to Mediterranean cuisine. We're experimenting with "cleaner" forms, making smaller interventions, and allowing the raw ingredients to breathe. At the same time, the atmosphere we're creating in the space aims to be as close as possible to the experience of a welcoming summer table by the sea.

What does the award for Yevo at the FnL Awards mean to you?

I'm not part of the YĒVO team, but I feel proud that such achievements exist within the same group. Having creative work recognised is a great motivation for all of us to continue raising the bar.

How do you think local identity blends with international gastronomic trends? Personally, I believe that we should

always start with local ingredients and stories. There's no need to "imitate" an international trend. However, we can creatively assimilate it—through technique, aesthetics, and the experience of the dish. The goal isn't to create something modern, but to create something authentic in a modern way.

What do you particularly appreciate about the island's local products?

The power they have to connect you to the land. You smell fresh thyme or open a jar of Mykonian capers, and suddenly you "see" the landscape. I love working with simple ingredients—chickpeas, herbs, greens—and giving them a new form on the plate, without losing their origin.

In your opinion, what makes Mykonos so unique and resilient?

Mykonos has an almost magnetic force. It's an island of contrasts—air and land, luxury and simplicity. And despite its difficulties or excesses, it always finds a way to redefine itself. It's as though it has a code of freedom that never changes.


What makes a chef go from good to great?

Consistency. Not only in taste but also in behaviour, in how they collaborate, how they listen, how they're inspired. When you continue to evolve, to learn, without forgetting the "why" behind your cooking, that's when you improve. Good food has technique, but the best food also has soul.

How easy is it to be a couple with mr Bakopoulos both in life and at work?

It's beautiful, but it requires balance. Cooking is already a demanding "relationship". When you have your partner in the same environment, it takes maturity to separate the roles. With Angelos, we've found a common rhythm and we respect the fact that, although we share the same passion, we have different approaches—and this makes us stronger.







The new rules

ANTONY GORMLEY'S RULE II FINDS A PERMANENT HOME ON ANCIENT DELOS AND INVITES TO A DIALOGUE BETWEEN PAST AND PRESENT. BY DIMITRIS GOLEBOS



Rule II, by renowned British artist Antony Gormley, is the first contemporary artwork to be permanently installed in a Greek archaeological site. Quietly seated outside the Archaeological Museum of Delos, the sculpture stands as a lasting gesture of cultural resonance and renewal. The artwork was originally created for NEON's landmark 2019 exhibition called "Sight", where a series of Antony Gormley's sculptures where exhibited in the island for five months. Now, the human-like form returns to the sacred island not as a visitor, but as a resident, gifted by the artist and NEON to the Hellenic Ministry of Culture. This permanent installation marks the beginning of a broader initiative by NEON to integrate contemporary art into Greece's ancient landscapes, forming new

narratives across time. The aim: to open new ways of seeing, feeling, and connecting with the past through the lens of living creativity. The sculpture's form is stark yet human, abstract yet familiar. A presence that invites contemplation rather than explanation. On an island shaped by myth, worship, and silence, Rule II does not compete with the past. It listens. It endures. Here, in the blinding Cycladic light, the ancient and the modern breathe the same air, and for a moment, time bends.

MEGALI AMMOS

The beach is ideal for a quick dip for those who want to keep within a safe distance from Chora. Accessible even on foot, the golden beach with fine sand and northerly winds is also a great place for windsurfing, and a luxurious stay with high dining. KAPARI

A western beach that is worth visiting late in the afternoon. A ten-minute walk from Agios Ioannis and you will arrive at one of the island's last havens. Nudists and old Mykonos devotees gather here daily, while the concept of organization is completely absent. Dive into the sea from the smooth rocks at the end of the beach and seek your privacy.


AGIOS IDANNIS

Protected from both northerly and southerly winds, the beach is divided in two by some gentle rocks and boasts the stunning sunset featured in the 1989 film, Shirley Valentine. Among the beach's strong points are the interesting seabed towards the right, ideal for snorkeling, the very fine pebbles that are perfect

ORNOS

The island's most popular family beach attracts all types of tourists, Greek families and quite a few locals. The natural barrier created by the settlement's houses blocks the strong north wind which often pounds the island, while the south wind does not affect the sea since the bay, while large, is closed and protected. Ornos' long sandy beach has numerous restaurants and café-bars with tables all the way to the sand.

AGIOS STEFANOS

This is an ideal beach for those who wish to avoid high society, admire the magnificent views of the Small Delos islands and enjoy a magical sunset with the locals. If you feel adventurous, keep driving towards the protected Houlakia beach. Swim to the small cove behind the rocky shoreline and benefit from this idyllic location despite the strong winds.

RHENIA

The only way to visit Rhenia is by boat, as it is the island opposite of Delos. Hidden caves and virgin beaches await those who get there. There are four unique and isolated beaches with golden-white sand and crystal-clear waters with blue-green colour on the island: Glyfada, Stena, Lia and Ambelia. Take a small beach hopping journey to admire them all.

PSAROU

It has been experiencing glory days since the 1980s, setting the summer's trends and defining the concept of luxury living on Mykonos. It boasts warm waters even from early Spring. The road is quite narrow with sharp turns and requires attention. You will come here to see and be-seen. You must definitely make time to enter the design world of Nammos Village with many famous luxury fashion brands (nammosvillage.com).

PLATIS GIALOS

Protected from the winds and beautiful albeit packed, Platis Gialos is fairly developed. Its big advantage is its sporty character and the plethora of restaurants and hotels that line the beach. The hotels, sunbeds and parasols usually attract families and young couples.

AGIA ANNA (PARAGA)

Agia Anna still maintains, to a degree, the image of a quiet, family beach, functioning as a discharging point from its two noisy neighbours. The beach faces southwest and gets the sun until late, offering the opportunity for long-term sunbathing before or after enjoying the authentic recipes of Nikolas taverna (nikolas-taverna.com).

PARAGA

It is the first beach on the island to open and the last to close, since its favourable orientation guarantees warm days from May to October. There is easy parking at both entrances: from Agia Anna and just before Paradise. Get ready for frenzied dancing

at SantAnna (santannamykonos.com) and the bohemian style of Scorpios as you enjoy its vibes until the night hours (scorpiosmykonos.com).

PARADISE

It is among the first of the island's hot spots to strongly support the nudist dogma. Numerous beach bars are lined on the beach, inspiring people to get up and dance. The beach is also accessible by sea on small boats (caiques) which depart from Ornos and Platis Gialos. The nights at Cavo Paradiso with a dazzling DJ line-up are unforgettable (cavoparadiso.gr).

SUPER PARADISE

Super Paradise has entered a new era of partying, connecting with each other and enjoying life, charged with the special energy that this beautiful beach in Mykonos has been radiating for over fifty years. A landmark holiday destination, the new Super Paradise Beach Club is a place where guests from around the world become co-travellers in the journey of authentic, most-modern bohemian fun, partying moments, relaxation, and pampering with mouth-watering food options, sensational wines and creative cocktails. AGIOS SOSTIS

No make-up, bars, shops, tourist enterprises or sunbeds. With wonderful deep blue waters, it favours snorkeling fans. Here you will see celebrities and anonymous nudists, as well as locals. Best from May to mid-July and then in September; avoid the August meltemi winds which make conditions unwelcoming. You could go by your own vehicle or by taxi.

PANORMOS

The livelier beach of Mykonos remains a quiet corner. This ex-hippie and nudist haunt is reminiscent of old Mykonos, while it has a wild beauty with its colours changing throughout the day. Choose Panormos if you want a break from the large crowds and enjoy a truly magical

scenery. At the same time, if you prefer more cosmopolitan vibes, Principote is the perfect place-to-be in the pristine beach of Panormos. It is a club beyond the ordinary, where luxury rises to a whole new realm amidst comfortable elegance and discreet service (principote.com).

FTELIA

Ftelia is divided into two by a rock formation that reaches the sea. Starting from Chora, take a left turn at the crossroads to discover the ideal surfing destination and admire a performance offered by the virtuoso surfers. When it is not windy, the landscape is reminiscent of a lagoon and the beach is frequented by a number of locals. On the other side of Ftelia, you have to feel the energy of the iconic Alemagou beach bar restaurant with its stunningly luxurious yet rough topography, enhanced by the dominating natural conditions such as the wind, the sun and the dry Cycladic coastline (alemagou.gr).

FOKOS & MYRSINI

Fokos still remains an untouched treasure, as buses don't reach this beach, with shallow green water and thick sand. Picturesque and calm with the island's coldest waters, it is located right after the artificial lake of Ano Mera and is quite seriously affected by the north winds. Myrsini is the next beach with crystalclear green waters. While in Fokos, try the picturesque Fokos Taverna with delicacies inspired by traditional Mykonian and Mediterranean cuisine, made with fresh, seasonal ingredients.

ELIA

A lot of people prefer Elia as the best beach on the island, ideal for water sports and for families. You must visit to discover it for yourself! Do not forget that it is one of the bigger sandy beaches on the island and that it preserves its bohemian feeling. It is better to visit it on days with a north wind for calm waters.

AGRARI


On the south side of the island, Agrari introduces its charm and calmness. It has sun loungers and water sports and can also be accessed by small boats from Platis Gialos. The beach's right-hand side, by the rocks, is ideal for diving and playing games in the clear blue water. KALO LIVADI

In the southern eastern part of the island, you will find one of the best organized beaches with a strong cosmopolitan feel, which covers every entertainment and taste expectation. Indulge in this long, yellow sandy beach with green-blue clear waters, abundant umbrellas, sunbeds and water sports. Solymar is an ideal choice because it is designed in harmony with its natural surroundings, offering you the chance to experience Mykonos with all your senses (solymarmykonos.com).

KALAFATIS

This is one of the island's biggest beaches and even when crowded, it offers a sense of space which is ideal for families. The sand is quite pebbly, while there are many trees for natural shade. Get

AGIA ANNA (KALAFATIS)

Drive a bit further past Kalafatis or walk a few minutes to find the somewhat hidden little beach. With clean, emerald waters and sand that continues some distance into the sea, the beach is embraced by ancient Divounia, which act as wind breakers for its calm and velvet sandy beach. Don't miss a sunset dinner at Spilia Seaside (spiliarestaurant.gr).

LIA

Lia is the last of the southern beaches that you can go by car. A small bay with deep crystal waters protected from the strong northerly winds which is ideal for snorkeling. This is the alternative preferred by celebrities who arrive by boat. Get ready for a more secluded experience, walk over the rocks to reach the neighbouring Tigani beach. But before that, have a look at Liasti beach club (liastimykonos.com)

Experience a sunset in Alemagou beach in Ftelia to turn the magic hour into a glorious event.
